

Health Portal Requirements for the EMS Program

- American Heart Association BLS Certification
- Pre-Admission Medical History Exam
- Proof of Immunizations
- Proof of Varicella (Chicken Pox) immunization or titer
- Proof of Hepatitis B immunization or titer
- Proof of Measles-Mumps-Rubella immunization or titer
- Proof of Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis (Td/Tdap/P) vaccination within the last 10 years
- Proof of 2-step negative TB test or negative chest x-ray in the case of a positive skin test; TB test must be repeated annually.
- Influenza Vaccines repeated annually.
- Students must have proof of complete vaccination against COVID-19 or an approved NCMC waiver. In general, people are considered fully vaccinated:
 - 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines; or
 - 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine.
 - *If you do not meet these requirements, you are NOT fully vaccinated regardless of your age.*
- A negative 10-panel drug screen completed no earlier than 30 days before clinical rotation.
