A request for a degree may not be approved unless the applicant begins his/her final semester with a 2.0 cumulative grade point average and may reasonably be expected to have completed all necessary coursework satisfactorily by the date the degree is to be awarded. To graduate with a degree, a student must complete the total number of credit hours required for the degree being sought, even if courses have been waived or competency has been demonstrated through ACT, SAT, COMPASS or ACCUPLACER scores and have an overall cumulative 2.0 GPA.

5. Students who have achieved a total cumulate grade point average as indicated below by the beginning of their final semester may graduate with honors.
