RESIDENCY POLICY AND DEFINITIONS:



NORTH CENTRAL MICHIGAN COLLEGE

It is the policy of North Central Michigan College to determine a student's residency status when first admitted. A student will maintain that status until that student applies for and is granted a change or moves outside Emmet County.

Residency classifications are as follows:

In-District Residing in Emmet County prior to the first day of classes of the semester for

which the student plans to register.

Out-District Residing in Michigan prior to the first day of classes of the semester for which

the student plans to register.

Out-of-State Residing anywhere outside the state of Michigan.

1) An approved change in residency status for tuition assessment is not retroactive to any previous semester.

2) Copies of all documentation are due along with the completed Application for Residency Change on or before the last day to register of the semester you petition for a change.

Acceptable Documentation (a copy of one of the following <u>must</u> be submitted with the application):

- Michigan Driver's License.
- Lease Agreement (Your name <u>must</u> be in the lease).
- Property tax receipt (if you reside in Emmet County).
- Voter's registration card.
- Identification card from the Secretary of State Office.
